- Prior Rabies Certificate is required for a 3-year Rabies vaccine; otherwise vaccine will be good for 1 year
- Bring other vaccine records if possible
- Only healthy pets can be vaccinated
- If you have a CAT go immediately to Cashier's table
- Flea & Tick Control available (price depends on pet's weight)
- Anal gland expression (\$5)
- Prices below are "CASH" prices
- NO checks are accepted
- \$3 additional per pet for non-cash transactions (Debit/Credit Cards)
- \$2 Hazardous Materials Disposal Fee will be charged per pet
- Although unlikely, prices are subject to change (current prices are always posted on our website)
- Low-Cost Dental Cleaning, Extractions & Other Services offered at our Wellness Clinics in Orange County (Dental care by appointment only - view our website Calendar for dates & details)

We can NOT vaccinate a pet which:

- ✓ Has ever had an adverse reaction to a vaccine
- ✓ Has shown any sign of illness in the past two weeks
- ✓ Is nursing puppies or kittens
- ✓ Might be pregnant

Notify our staff upon arrival if your pet is on medication, is undergoing any medical treatment, or may possibly have any medical/health condition. Keep a safe distance between your pet and other pets & people.
Dogs must be on leashes & cats must be in carriers (no cardboard carriers allowed).

MICROCHIPS for DOGS & CATS \$30

(Includes Microchip Registration & 24/7 Lost & Found Pet Recovery Assistance)

ROUNDWORM DE-WORMING \$13 per dose

TAPEWORM DE-WORMING \$15 - \$35 per dose

RABIES (Thimerosal Free for DOGS & CATS) (12 wks & older) **\$7** (Purevax Non-Adjuvant - CATS only) 1 yr: **\$20** 3 yr: **\$48**

The first Rabies vaccine is good for 1 year, regardless of pet's age. Thereafter, Rabies vaccines are good for 3 years as long as at least 12 months have passed since the pet received its first Rabies vaccination and valid proof of a prior Rabies vaccination by a licensed veterinarian in the U.S. is provided.

DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvo & Parainfluenza) - or - **DHP** (Distemper, Hepatitis & Parvo) (6 wks & older) **\$20**

ORAL BORDETELLA (Bronchiseptica) - or - **INTRANASAL BORDETELLA w/PARAINFLUENZA** (4 wks & older) **\$15**

LYME (Borrelia Burgdorferi) (9 wks & over) **\$22**

FVRCP (Non-Adjuvant) (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calici, and Panleukopenia) (6 wks & over) **\$20**

FELV (Non-Adjuvant) (Feline Leukemia) (8 wks & over) **\$22**

♥ Pets should always receive an initial series of vaccinations, then boosters in one year. Thereafter, annual vaccinations or vaccinations every three years are recommended, depending on the type of vaccine and on the pet's environment. Ideally, pets should receive one of their sets of initial vaccines between 14 to 16 weeks of age to achieve the best immunity against disease. During your pet's initial vaccine series, do not wait longer than 6 weeks apart to have your pet vaccinated and do not vaccinate less than 2 weeks apart. ♥ All pets adopted from shelters or elsewhere when the pet's vaccine history is unknown should receive the appropriate vaccine booster(s) 1 month after adoption. ♥

DOG LICENSES 2018

Officers from the Los Angeles County Dept. of Animal Care and Control will be available at the June 28th clinic from 5:30pm – 7:30pm to renew or issue new dog licenses. Please bring a copy of your dog's current rabies vaccination certificate and spay or neuter certificate.

FEES:

Spayed or Neutered:	\$12
Unaltered:	\$24

Cash or checks (for licenses only) accepted. Please make checks payable to “County of Los Angeles Animal Care & Control”. Please be sure to have your dog on a leash and please be prepared to clean up after your pet.

BEING A COURTEOUS PET OWNER

As you enjoy your pet, we ask that you be a mindful neighbor by following the tips below:

- Clean-up after your dog. It is unlawful for your dog to leave waste on private or public property. Cleaning up after your dog reflects your consideration of others.
- Keep your dog leashed or within a secure fenced area. Be aware that it is unlawful for any animal to freely stray in Palos Verdes Estates. This is also a great way to protect your dog from dangers of the outside world.
- Prevent pet boredom. It is unlawful for owners to leave their dog barking for an excessive amount of time at the disturbance of others. Excessive barking is often the result of boredom or anxiety. Take time each day to walk your dog, play with him or teach him new tricks.

REMINDER CHECKLIST:

- CASH ONLY for veterinary services
- Checks OK for licenses
- Prior rabies certificate in order to receive 3-year vaccine, otherwise good for 1-year
- Spay or Neuter certificate and rabies certificate for new license
- Leash or carrier
- Cat owners please try to come at 5:30

JUST A FRIENDLY REMINDER! KEEP YOUR PETS SAFE

COYOTE SAFETY TIPS:

Never leave pets unattended outdoors. Do not permit your pets to “play” or interact with Coyotes. Keep pets on a shorter leash as long leashed (or no leash) pets can be snatched up by Coyotes. And clean up after your pet. Don't leave animal waste or pet food in your yard. Coyotes are attracted to both.



As always, dogs must be on leashes at all times, except when confined to your property!
