

City Manager's Meeting Preview

On March 5, 2019, LA County conducted the General Municipal Election for the City of Palos Verdes Estates for 3 seats on the City Council. The new members of the City Council will be sworn in at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on March 26, 2019. In this transition period, the City Council will not be meeting; there is no Council meeting on March 12, 2019.

Over the next two weeks, the Los Angeles County Registrar Recorder / County Clerk will be completing the ballot count and final canvass of the election. The results of the election will subsequently be reported at the City Council meeting on March 26th. The March 26th City Council meeting is to recognize the service of the outgoing City Councilmembers, swear in the new City Councilmembers, and for the City Council to elect a Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem. No business will be conducted on March 26th other than a few Consent Agenda items for meeting the City's obligations. The meeting will be followed with a celebration of service with light snacks and drinks.

The community is encouraged to attend the March 26th City Council meeting to recognize the retiring Councilmembers. The meeting will be held in the Council Chambers and will begin at 7:30 p.m.

The City Council will next convene with a full agenda of business on April 9, 2019.
