

## **City Manager's Meeting Preview**

*On April 9, 2019, the City Council will meet in Regular Session at 7:30 p.m. for several matters of business that are calendared on its agenda.*

*On the Consent Agenda, along with other matters, will be the award of an agreement to Michael Baker International for a traffic corridor study in the area bounded by the entry triangle (Palos Verdes Drive North and Palos Verdes Drive West) to Via Corta, and the appropriation of grant funds (Citizen's Options for Public Safety, also known as COPS funds) for both extending the subscription of the City's emergency community notification system and multijurisdictional cooperation with south bay cities.*

*The following items, in no particular order, will be on the agenda as Old Business or New Business:*

*Overview of the new Federal Communications Commission regulations and permit processing requirements pertaining to "small cells" (the installation of 5G cell site antennas) in cities.*

*Consideration and determination of filling the unexpired term of the City Treasurer.*

*Finance Advisory Committee financial forecast and projection.*

*Municipal Code amendment to allow the city manager to waive limitation on removal within 90 days after a municipal election.*

*Discussion and consideration of a hiring freeze.*

*Discussion and consideration of scheduling the Finance Director and / or the Finance Advisory Committee on the City Council agenda for regular updates on finance / fiscal matters.*

*Discussion and determination of completing a citywide infrastructure and maintenance Needs Assessment.*

*Selection of a Mayor Pro Tem.*

*Discussion and consideration of revising the City Council policy for the selection of Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem.*

*Discussion and consideration of revising the City Council policy for the formulation and scheduling of items on City Council agendas.*
