**10-21-2021                      Drugs and Firearm Violation                      2400 Blk PVDW**

At approximately 8:26 PM, an officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver for Possession of a Controlled Substance, Carrying a Loaded Firearm in Public and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**10-22-2021                      Mail Theft                      2400 Blk Via Rivera**

Between approximately 9:00 PM and 5:00 AM, unknown suspect(s) gained access to unlocked mailboxes and removed mail before fleeing the location with the mail in an unknown direction.
