### CRIME DATA

In July of 2022, there were three Part 1 crimes: 1 burglary, 1 attempted burglary, and 1 larceny (Theft).

**Burglary:** Unknown suspect(s) entered a fenced construction site by unknown means. Suspect(s) removed miscellaneous construction tools and fled the location with the victim’s property.

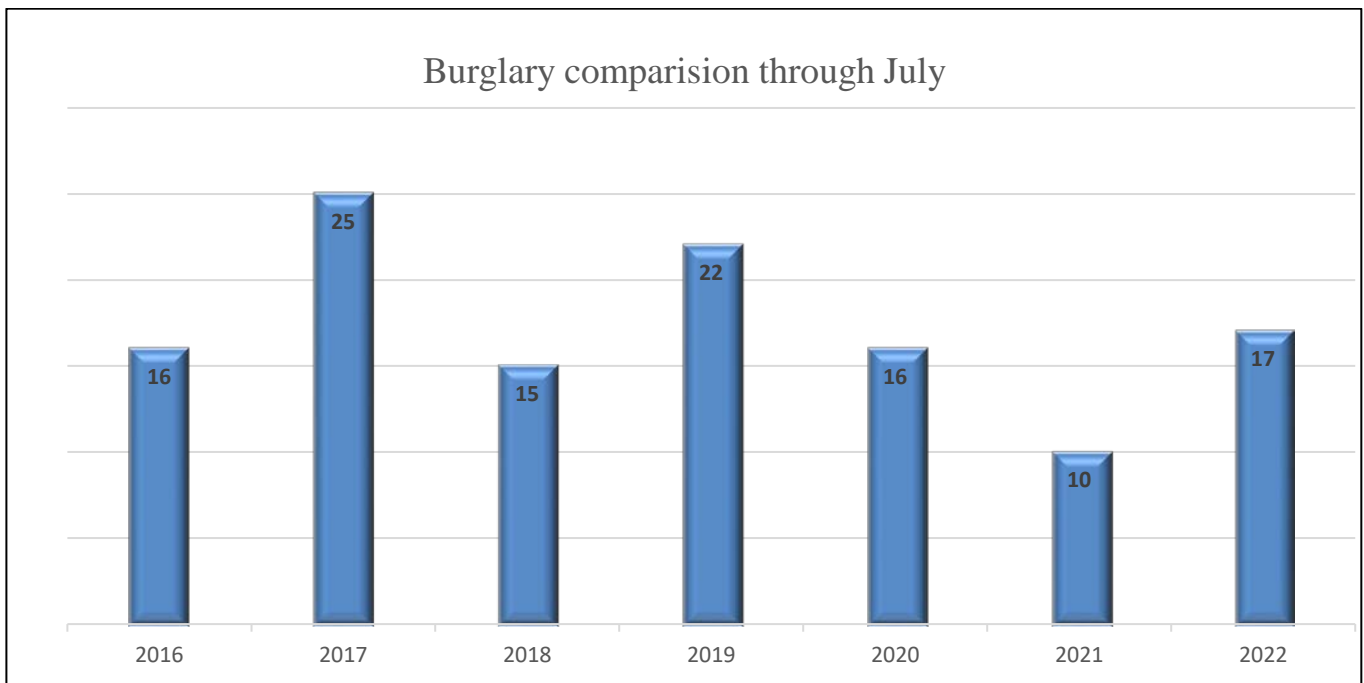
**Attempted Burglary:** PVEPD Officers were contacted via telephone by the homeowner, who advised of masked subjects tampering with her home video surveillance cameras at the residence. PVEPD Officers arrived on the scene and detained the mentioned subjects on the front porch area of the residence. Upon further investigation, PVEPD Officers noticed the camera lens to one of the surveillance cameras had been spray painted to obstruct the camera from capturing the incident. Upon further investigation, officers located a can of spray paint

and burglary tools on the suspects' persons. PVEPD Officers subsequently arrested three suspects for burglary.

Larceny: Unknown suspect(s) entered the victim's locked vehicle by unknown means. Suspect(s) removed the victim's property and fled the area.

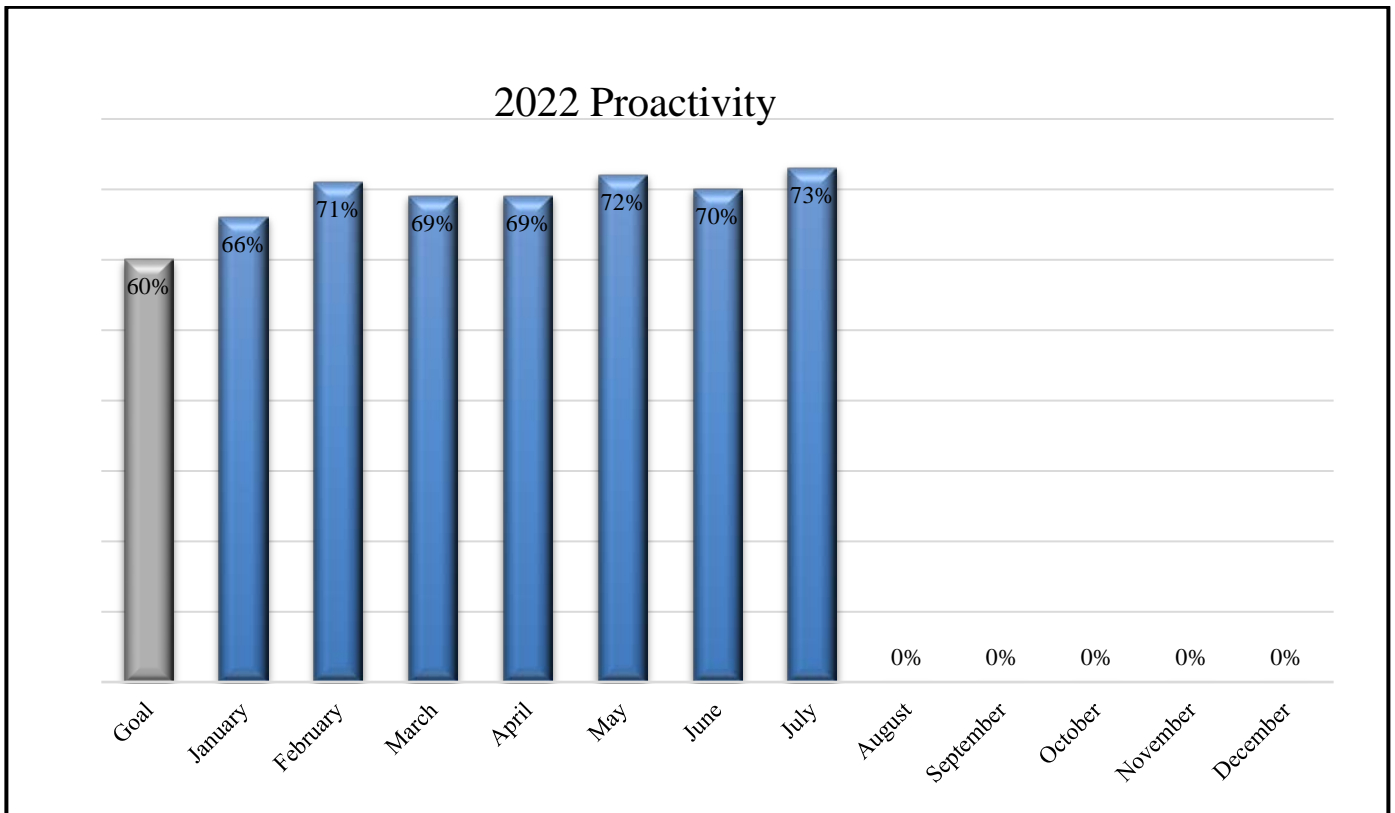

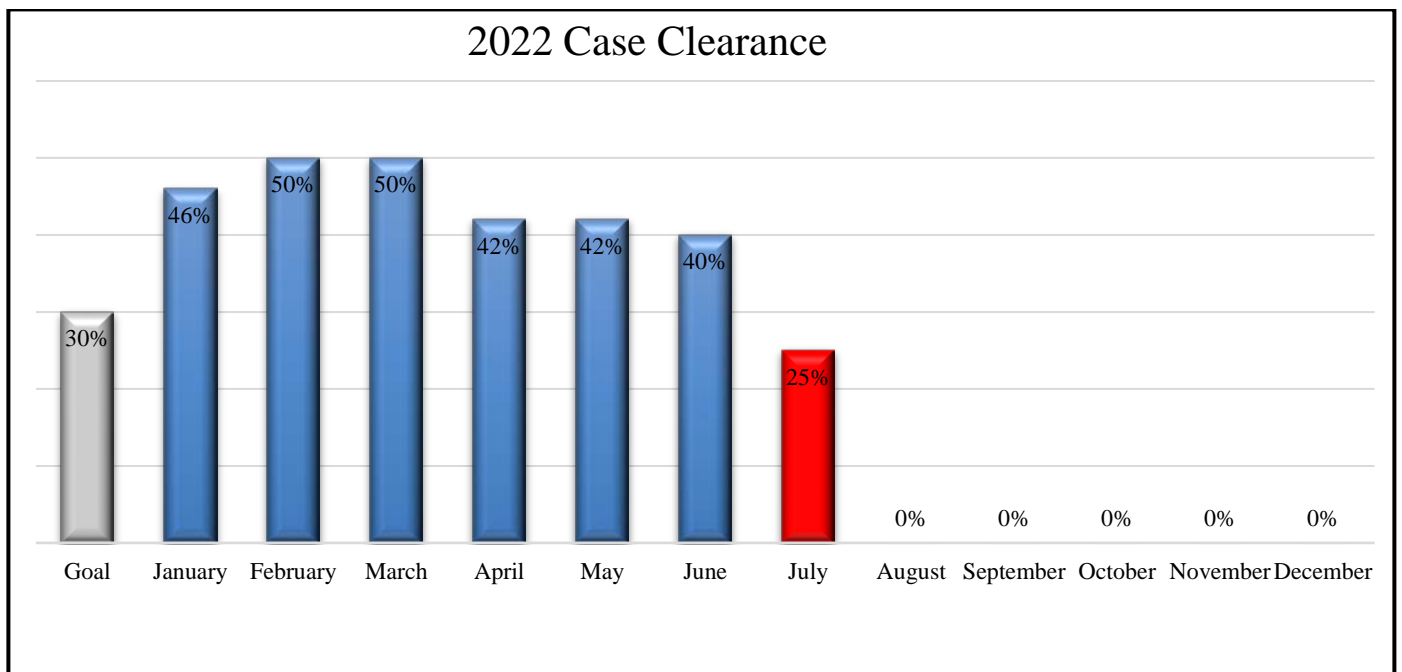

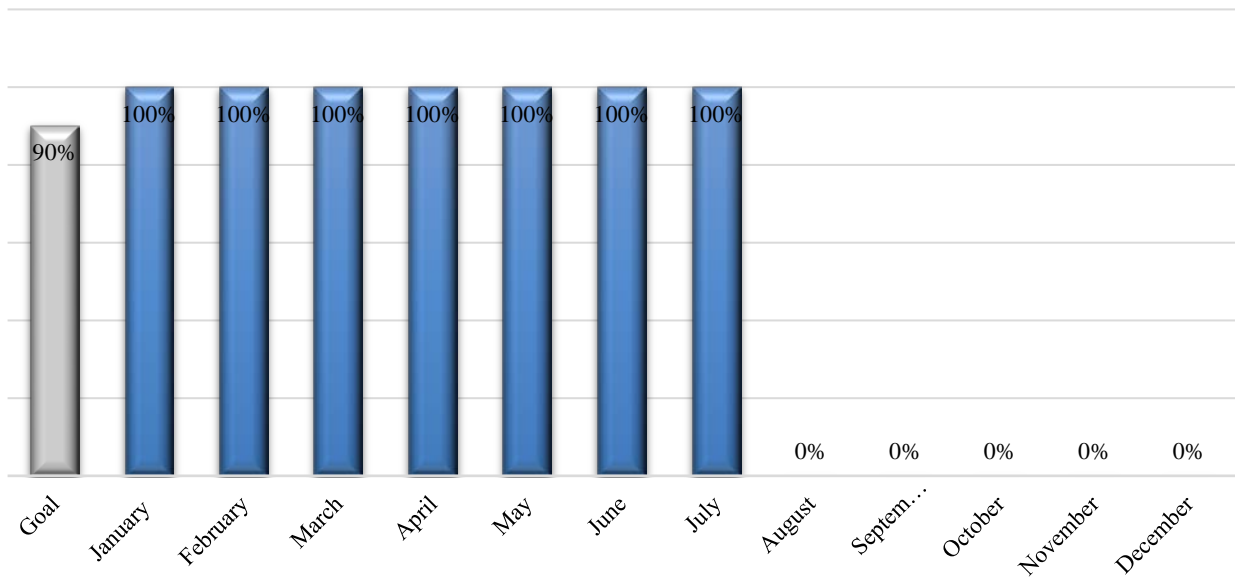
