08-08-2022 Arrest – DUI 3400 Block, Palos Verdes Drive North

At approximately 2:08 PM, an officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop, but the male driver didn't immediately pull over and traveled at speeds of 45-50 MPH. After almost colliding with another vehicle, the male driver, with a male passenger, pulled over. The investigation led to an arrest of the driver for DUI and driving with a suspended driver's license.

08-08-2022 Citation – Petty Theft 500 Block, Paseo Del Mar

At approximately 11:16 PM, officers conducted a traffic stop of a male bicyclist riding without a bicycle light, which is required at night. The investigation led to a citation for petty theft.

08-09-2022 Arrest – DUI Drugs 100 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 1:24 AM, officers responded to a request for assistance by another officer who conducted a traffic stop of a male driver with dark tinted windows. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for DUI drugs and being an unlicensed driver.

08-11-2022 Arrest – DUI on Alcohol / Drugs 1300 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 1:50 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop of a male driver and a female passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the driver for DUI on alcohol / drugs.

08-11-2022 Arrest – Drugs 700 Block, Via Del Monte

At approximately 12:05 PM, officers were dispatched to a possible reckless driver traveling up Via Del Monte. Another officer contacted the male driver and female passenger. The investigation led to a misdemeanor citation for possession of Nitrous Oxide.

08-12-2022 Burglary Report 700 Block, Mexico Place

At approximately 5:40 PM, officers were dispatched to a burglary that had just occurred in the upstairs kitchen, while the owner of the home was downstairs folding laundry. The victim interrupted the suspect. The female suspect fled on foot before the victim could call the police.
