10-11-22 Arrest/Drugs 800 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 4:23 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a male driver and a female passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of a controlled substance; and arrest of the female driver for possession of methamphetamine.

10-12-2022 Catalytic Converter Theft Report 4400 Block, Via Pavion

At approximately 3:47 AM, officers were dispatched in reference to a possible catalytic converter theft (Grand Theft). Unknown suspect(s) removed the catalytic converter from victim's vehicle without permission, and fled the scene.

10-13-2022 Warrant Arrest 4000 Block, Via Opatá (PV Stables)

At approximately 10:18 AM, officers contacted a male at the Palos Verdes Stables. The investigation led to an arrest for outstanding warrants.

10-15-2022 Forgery 2600 Block, Via Olivera

On 10/6/22 at approximately 4:00 PM, the victim placed two checks in his mailbox located in front of his residence near the roadway. Unknown suspect(s) obtained victim's mail and removed the victim's checks. The suspects(s) then deposited / cashed fraudulent checks in the suspect(s) name.

10-15-2022 Burglary Report 4200 Block, Via Pinzon

Sometime between 3:30 PM and 11:15 PM, unknown suspects(s) smashed west-facing master bedroom glass door and gained entry into the residence. Suspect(s) ransacked the master bedroom, guest bedroom and closets, and then fled the location in an unknown direction by unknown means.

10-16-2022 Theft Report 200 Block, Via Colusa

At approximately 11:51 AM, officers were dispatched in reference to a possible Grand Theft. Unknown suspect(s) entered the victim's unlocked vehicle by unknown means and removed victim's golf bag / clubs and digital range finder, and fled in an unknown direction by unknown means.
