10-22-22 Arrest / Accident / Suspicion of DUI 100 Palos Verdes Drive West, Triangle

At approximately 11:08 PM, officers were dispatched in reference to a traffic collision. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for suspicion of DUI.

10-23-22 Burglary Report 2700 Block, Via Victoria

Sometime between October 9 and October 23, unknown suspects(s) used unknown means to break the glass window pane of a side door and entered the victim's residence. Once inside, the suspect(s) ransacked the upstairs bedroom and dresser and then fled the location undetected.

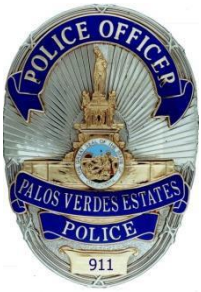
10-28-22 Arrest / Criminal Threat / Elder Abuse 2200 Block, Via Cerritos
