11-8-22 Warrant Arrest Silver Spur Road & Palos Verdes Drive North

At approximately 11:40 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to an arrest of the male driver for an active outstanding misdemeanor warrant.

11-9-22 Theft from Vehicle 2600 Block, Via Ramon

Sometime between 11/8/22 at 7:50 PM and 11/9/22 at 5:50 AM, unknown suspect(s) gained access to the victim's unlocked vehicles, removed items from two vehicles, and fled the location undetected by unknown means.

11-9-22 Vehicle Burglary 2600 Block, Via Ramon

Sometime between 11/8/22 at 6 PM and 11/9/22 at 6 AM, unknown suspect(s) broke the back left driver-side window of victim's vehicle, removed property, and fled the scene undetected, in an unknown direction by unknown means.

11-9-22 Vehicle Burglary 2600 Block, Via Segunda

Sometime between 11/8/22 at 6 PM and 11/9/22 at 6:45 AM, unknown suspect(s) broke a window of the victim's vehicle, removed property, and then fled in an unknown direction.

11-9-22 Vehicle Burglary 2600 Block, Via Ramon

Sometime between 11/8/22 at 4:30 PM and 11/9/22 at 7 AM, unknown suspect(s) broke the driver-side window, entered the victim's locked vehicle, removed property, and then fled the scene undetected.

11-9-22 Theft from Vehicle 800 Block, Paseo Del Mar

Sometime between 11/8/22 at 9:40 PM and 11/9/22 at 8 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered victim's gated property, removed property from victim's unlocked vehicle, and fled the location with stolen property undetected.

11-9-22 Arrest – Drugs 3100 Block, Palos Verdes Drive North

At approximately 10:10 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a female driver and a front male passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the female driver for possession of drug paraphernalia—and she was issued a misdemeanor citation.
