11-14-22 **Arrest – Drugs** **Via Del Puente & Via Almar**

At approximately 11:08 PM, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a male driver and a female front passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of drug paraphernalia and driving without a license, and the arrest of the female passenger for possession of methamphetamine and resisting, obstructing and delaying Police officers.

11-16-22 **Identity Theft** **4000 Block, Via Nivel**

At approximately 11:25 AM, an officer was dispatched in reference to an identity theft courtesy report. Unknown suspect(s) obtained victim's personal identifying information by unknown means and used the information to open a Verizon account.

11-17-22 **Catalytic Converter Theft Report** **3300 Block, Via Campesina / Golf Course**

Sometime between 9 AM and 12 Noon, unknown suspect(s) cut and removed the catalytic converter (grand theft) from the victim's vehicle, and fled the area undetected. The victim realized something was wrong when he started his vehicle and heard a much louder noise than before coming from the engine.

11-17-22 **Burglary Report** **2800 Block, Via De La Guerra**

Sometime between 9 AM and 6 PM on 11/2/22, unknown suspects(s) entered the residence, removed property and fled the location with the property, undetected.

11-19-22 **Arrest – Drugs** **300 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West**

At approximately 12:40 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop of a female driver and a male front passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the male passenger for possession of drug paraphernalia and possession of methamphetamine, and the arrest of the female driver for possession of a controlled substance (cocaine).

11-20-22 **Arrest – Drugs** **1300 Block, Paseo Del Mar (Turnout)**

At approximately 1:03 AM, an officer contacted a female driver and a male front passenger—both asleep in an illegally parked vehicle. The investigation led to the arrest of the female driver for possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of methamphetamine and heroin, and an outstanding warrant for burglary.
