11-26-22 Arrest – Drugs 2700 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 11:22 PM, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a male driver and a female front passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of a controlled substance; and the female passenger was arrested for possession of a controlled substance.

11-27-22 Arrest – Drugs 3000 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 2:26 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a male driver and a female front passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the female passenger for possession of a controlled substance.

11-28-22 Arrest – Drugs 1300 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 1:45 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of drug paraphernalia, and also issued a citation for driving without a license in California.

11-28-22 Arrest / Impaired Driver 500 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 5:20 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for DUI. Later, driving with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher was added to his charges.

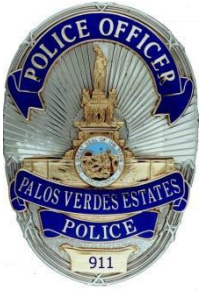
12-1-22 Burglary Report 900 Block, Via Mirada

Sometime between 11/20/22 and 12/1/22 at 8:05 AM, unknown suspect(s) smashed the side master bedroom bathroom glass window and gained access to the residence. Once inside, suspect(s) ransacked drawers and closet in the master bedroom. Suspect(s) possibly removed items prior to exiting through the same broken window. Suspect(s) then fled the area in an unknown direction by unknown means.

12-1-22 Theft Report 2400 Via Campesina / Malaga Cove Library

At approximately 4:30 PM on 11/26/22, the victim finished working an event and packed up his musical equipment and temporarily stored it near the Library kitchen area, and then loaded it into his vehicle. The following day, 11/27/22, he realized some of his music equipment was missing.

12-1-22 **Arrest – Drugs** **300 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West**
At approximately 11:33 PM, officers conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of methamphetamine.

12-3-22 **Arrest / Impaired Driver** **500 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West**
At approximately 1:52 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for DUI with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher.

12-3-22 **Arrest / Impaired Driver** **Palos Verdes Drive West/Via Corta**
At approximately 1:58 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a male driver and a female front passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for DUI, and later—driving with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher was added to his charges.

At approximately 2:31 AM, an officer made contact with a male driver and female passenger in an illegally parked vehicle. The investigation led to an arrest of the male driver for being drunk in public, possessing brass knuckles and for an outstanding misdemeanor warrant.
