ARREST

3-13-23 Arrest – Outstanding Warrants 700 Block, Paseo Lunado

At approximately 11:19 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to an arrest of the unlicensed male driver for outstanding warrants.

3-14-23 Arrest – Drugs 2800 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 4:21 PM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the female driver for possession of psilocybin/cocaine and also possession of a controlled substance.

3-17-23 Arrest – Drugs 700 Block, Paseo Del Mar

At approximately 12:16 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of methamphetamine; and arrest of the front female passenger for an outstanding misdemeanor warrant for petty theft.

3-17-23 Arrest – Impaired Driver 100 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 1:12 AM, officers contacted a driver with keys in the ignition and her vehicle engine still running. The driver appeared to be passed out or sleeping—even after she lost her vehicle tire approximately 200 feet behind. The investigation led to the arrest of the female driver for DUI.

3-17-23 Arrest – Outstanding Warrant 200 Block, Palos Verdes Drive West

At approximately 3:16 PM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for an outstanding no bail warrant.

3-18-23 Arrest – Weapons Violation 300 Block, Via Corta

At approximately 3:04 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop of a female driver and a front male passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the female driver for carrying a concealed firearm in a vehicle, possession of ecstasy and also for an outstanding warrant.

3-19-23 Arrest – Mail Theft / Drugs Malaga Cove Plaza

At approximately 1:27 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of burglary tools, forgery, mail theft, possession of methamphetamine and providing false information to a peace officer.

3-14-23 Theft 300 Block, Paseo Del Mar

Victim parked his vehicle and walked down to RAT beach to surf. Sometime between 7 AM and 8:10 AM, unknown suspect(s) removed victim's car key fob, house keys and bag, and fled the location in an unknown direction.

3-15-23 Theft from Vehicle (Grand Theft) 600 Block, Paseo Del Mar (Bluff Cove)

Sometime between 10 AM and 11 AM, unknown suspect(s) used victim's hidden key to gain access into the vehicle, removed victim's cell phones, wallet and credit cards, and fled undetected.

3-16-23 Theft from Vehicle (Grand Theft) 600 Block, Paseo Del Mar (Bluff Cove)

Sometime between 12:30 PM and 2 PM, unknown suspect(s) used victim's hidden key to gain access into the vehicle, removed victim's cell phones, wallet, credit cards and sunglasses, and fled the area undetected. Later that day, the victim's debit card was used to purchase items totaling \$6,900 at the Apple Store in Cerritos.

3-17-23 Theft from Vehicle (Grand Theft) 600 Block, Paseo Del Mar (Bluff Cove)

Sometime between 1 PM and 3 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered victim's locked vehicle by unknown means and removed removed victim's cell phone, wallet and credit cards, and fled undetected. Suspect(s) proceeded to use the victim's credit cards to make fraudulent purchases.
When using a lock box on your vehicle, make sure it is not within range of the vehicle's remote keyless entry.

Sometime between 12 Noon and 2:15 PM, the victim noticed that her mailbox was open and empty. Unknown suspect(s) took mail/package from victim's mailbox and fled the area undetected.
