ARREST

3-21-23 **Arrest – Impaired Driver** **800 Block, Paseo Del Mar**

At approximately 1:53 AM, an officer contacted a male driver and a front female passenger parked illegally. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for DUI.

3-23-23 **Arrest – Drugs** **1400 Block, Paseo Del Mar**

At approximately 12:16 AM, officers contacted a male driver and a male front passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for possession of a controlled substance and public intoxication.

3-23-23 **Arrest – Burglary tools** **500 Block, Palos Verdes Blvd**

At approximately 2:22 PM, an officer observed two males, one wearing a surgical style face mask, who appeared to be casing vehicles parked in the Bluff Cove area. When they saw the officer, they got into a car (lookout vehicle) parked along the curb line in the 600 block of Paseo Del Mar. The officer followed them onto PV Drive West and conducted a traffic stop of a male driver, front male passenger and left rear male passenger. The investigation led to the arrest of the driver and both passengers for possession of burglary tools, conspiracy to commit a crime and suspicion of burglary.

PD Detectives believe these suspects are responsible for several car thefts lately along 600 Block of Paseo Del Mar.

3-24-23 **Arrest – Impaired Driver** **600 Block, Palos Verdes Blvd**

At approximately 2:39 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop. The investigation led to the arrest of the male driver for DUI.
