ARRESTS

11-27-2024 Drugs

3900 BLK PALOS VERDES DR N

At approximately 8:57 PM, an officer observed a traffic violation and conducted a traffic stop. Another officer observed a glass smoking pipe with burnt with white residue and conducted a consensual search of the vehicle, which resulted in the arrest of the driver and two passengers for possession of methamphetamine and misappropriation of found property. One of the subjects was also arrested for nine outstanding warrants.

At approximately 10:29 PM, an officer observed a vehicle violation and conducted a traffic stop. Upon contacting the driver, the officer observed a marijuana pipe in the center console and conducted a standard field sobriety test and with probable cause, conducted a search of the vehicle. Inside of the vehicle, the officer located an empty alcoholic beverage can and a plastic bag containing marijuana. The driver was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence of drugs and alcohol.
