#### ARRESTS

#### NOT ON PREVIOUS WEEK'S ARRESTS

##### 1-01-2025 Theft

300 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W

At approximately 12:06 PM, an anonymous reporting party advised of a suspicious individual on a bicycle pushing a wheel barrel. At approximately 12:11 PM, an officer located the individual on the bicycle with the wheel barrel. The officer conducted a consensual contact and observed a variety of tools in the wheel barrel. His investigation revealed that the wheel barrel and tools were recently stolen from a construction site nearby and arrested the subject for possession of stolen property. During a search of the subject's person, the officer also located a debit card belonging to another person and determined the bicycle was not owned by the subject.

The passenger was determined to be an adult under 21 years of age and in possession of alcohol. The driver was cited for providing alcohol to a person under 21 years old.

At approximately 7:10 PM, officers responded to a call where dispatchers were observing via live feed that a subject was exiting the police garage with a large white bag. An officer made contact with the subject received verbal consent to search him and his belongings.
