ARRESTS

12-26-2024 Warrant Arrest

300 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W

At approximately 3:30 AM, an officer observed a vehicle code violation and conducted a traffic stop. During contact with the driver, the officer observed an open alcoholic beverage container in plain view. A record inquiry of the driver and 2 passenger's history/status through PVEPD dispatch revealed that the driver was unlicensed and one of the passengers had an outstanding warrant. The driver was cited for driving without a license and the passenger was arrested for the outstanding warrant.
