ARRESTS

1-28-2025 Impaired Driver

700 BLK PASEO DEL MAR

At approximately 4:18 AM, an officer responded to a report of a male screaming in the area. After searching the bluff top and surrounding area without locating anyone, a vehicle approached the officers, honking its horn. The driver appeared agitated, as if actively looking for someone. Officers observed that the vehicle failed to stop at a posted stop sign and swerved in the roadway. Based on these observations, a traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle. Upon contacting the driver, officers noted the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage and marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The officer conducted a series of standardized field sobriety tests, and the driver was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence.
