ARRESTS

2-16-2025 Reckless Driving

PALOS VERDES DR N & VIA COLUSA

At approximately 11:25 AM, officers observed a vehicle driving at a high rate of speed, failing to stop at a posted stop sign and evading police officers' attempt to conduct a traffic stop. After the vehicle came to a stop, the driver exited the vehicle and attempted to flee on foot. Officers pursued on foot and arrested the driver for reckless driving, obstruction, driving and driving on a suspended license.

02-08-2025 Impaired Driver

300 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W

At approximately 3:30 AM, an officer observed a vehicle code violation and conducted a traffic stop. The officer noticed the driver's eyes were glassy, watery and red/bloodshot, and their speech was slurred. Upon having the occupants exit the vehicle, the officer observed an open can of an alcoholic beverage inside. A probable cause search of the interior of the vehicle was conducted, and a small baggie containing a white powdery substance resembling cocaine along with a large amount of marijuana was located. Standardized Field Sobriety Tests were conducted on the driver, who was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol and possession of a controlled substance.

02-13-2025 Burglary

Sometime between 02-10-25 at approximately 2:00 PM and 02-13-25 at approximately 7:04 PM, unknown suspect(s) smashed the rear sliding glass door and gained access to the master bedroom. Suspect(s) entered through the broken glass and ransacked the master bedroom and opened drawers in other bedrooms. Suspect(s) removed unknown items and exited the residence through the same smashed sliding glass door and fled undetected.

At approximately 8:40 AM, officers responded to a report of a suspicious person, Officers located a subject matching the description. Based on the condition of the person, officers conducted a welfare check and subsequently requested paramedics to evaluate that individual. While waiting for fire department assistance, officers observed a large bulge in the front sweatshirt pocket and conducted a pat down search of the subject for weapons and located a small, sealed, clear plastic baggie containing a crystalline like substance. The subject was issued a citation for possession of methamphetamine and was transported to the hospital for medical treatment.

At approximately 8:012 PM, officers responded to a report of a party involving various juveniles. Arriving on scene, officers observed 15-20 juveniles, some dropping/throwing beer cans into the bushes before fleeing. After contacting the homeowner, officers issued an Administrative Citation for a violation of PVE Municipal Code 9.18.030- Social host liability.
