#### ARRESTS

##### **2-18-2025 Warrant Arrest**

**CLOYDEN RD & DALTON RD**

At approximately 9:34 AM, an officer observed a vehicle code violation and conducted a traffic stop. The driver was arrested for two active outstanding warrants.

##### **02-19-2025 Impaired Driver**

**MALAGA COVE PLAZA**

At approximately 9:14 PM, an officer observed a parked vehicle with the engine running. The officer observed the driver asleep in the driver seat and conducted a welfare check. The driver appeared disoriented, and the officer conducted a preliminary test for lack of smooth pursuit of the driver's eyes after noticing the smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from inside the vehicle. After conducting a series of standard field sobriety tests, the driver was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Based on the breath test results, the driver was also charged with driving with a blood alcohol content over .08%.

##### **02-21-2025 Drugs**

**2200 BLK VIA ANACAPA**

At approximately 10:25 AM, officers responded to a report of a suspicious person and located an individual matching the description. Upon witnessing a vehicle code violation, an officer initiated a traffic stop just as the subject quickly exited the vehicle. The individual appeared highly agitated, was unable to follow commands, and could not provide identification. The driver was subsequently arrested for driving on a suspended license. During an inventory search of the vehicle, officers discovered drug paraphernalia and methamphetamine. As a result, the individual was additionally charged with possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.

##### **02-21-2025 Drugs**

**300 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W**

At approximately 10:01 PM, an officer observed a vehicle committing two vehicle code violations, including driving on the wrong side of the road, and initiated a traffic stop. While speaking with the driver, the officer detected a strong odor of burnt marijuana and requested the occupants to exit the vehicle. Upon receiving consent to search the vehicle, the officer discovered a clear plastic baggie containing psilocybin, commonly known as magic mushrooms, inside a black backpack. A records check revealed the driver had a suspended license and two outstanding warrants. The driver was subsequently arrested for driving on a suspended license and the outstanding warrants.
