### **CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES (PUBLIC NOTICE – USE OF ROESSLER POINT GAZEBO & SUMMER ENFORCEMENT/EDUCATION PLAN) KNOWN AS THE GAZEBO EVENT 120 DAY PILOT PROGRAM**

**July 2025**

The City of Palos Verdes Estates is committed to protecting the beauty, safety, and accessibility of our treasured public spaces—including the iconic **Roessler Point Gazebo**. In response to increased activity at this location and to better serve both residents and vendors, the City is implementing a **summer enforcement and education initiative**, while **clarifying an important update to existing processes**.

#### **WHAT'S NEW?**

While **the municipal code requirements have not changed**, we are introducing a **permit processing component** for those planning private or commercial events at the gazebo.

Effective immediately, individuals or businesses **seeking to use the Roessler Gazebo** for proposals, photo shoots, weddings, or other gatherings are now expected to obtain the appropriate permits **in advance** of the event. This includes where applicable:

- A **business license** for any commercial activity (5.16.010 PVEMC)
- A **permit is required** if any objects, setups, or decorations are placed at the site (12.04.020 PVEMC)

#### **SUMMER EDUCATION & ENFORCEMENT PLAN**

**July–October 2025 (120 Day Period)**

During this period, the City will focus on:

- Educating the public and vendors on permit requirements and proper procedures
- Warning violators rather than citing immediately, as we transition to the new process
- Providing clear, proactive communication and assistance to those wishing to use the gazebo lawfully

Our goal is to ensure a smooth rollout of the updated permitting process while promoting fairness, safety, and accessibility for all users.

#### **PLAN AHEAD – STAY IN COMPLIANCE**

To avoid disruptions to your event:

- Check if your activity requires a permit
- Apply for permits in advance through the City's permitting office
- Reach out with any questions—we're here to help!
- Review City Website for guidelines and applications.
