

RESOLUTION NO. R23-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON VIA DEL MONTE, GATOS PALCE, VIA SOMONTE, AND VIA CONEJO

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates, California does hereby RESOLVE, DETERMINE, and ORDER as follows:

Section 1:

- A. Section 10.40.030 (Prohibited areas designated) of the Palos Verdes Estates Municipal Code (PVEMC) authorizes the City Council to establish no-parking areas; and
- B. Section 10.40.060 (Residential exemption) of the PVEMC authorizes the City Council to “identify specific areas in which residents may be exempted from posted parking restrictions if they obtain and display a permit or decal in a form approved by the City. The City Council may also establish a fee for the issuance of such permits or decals”; and
- C. The City Council finds that establishing such areas as no-parking areas and residential permit parking areas are within the public interest. The City Council recently heard from residents on Via Del Monte, Gatos Place, Via Somonte, and Via Conejo regarding concerns of safety on these roadways and the availability of parking, so the City Council wishes to restrict these areas to address the resident concerns.

Section 2: The following locations are established as no-parking areas with painted red curb and signage designating “no parking” and “tow-away zone:”

- The southern/uphill side of Via Del Monte from 10 feet east of 789 Via Del Monte to Gatos Place;
- The northern/downhill side of Via Del Monte from the western side of the parcel for 868 Via Somonte to the existing stop bar in between the parcels for 868 Via Somonte and 804 Via Del Monte; and

Section 3: The following locations are established as residential permit parking areas:

- The northern/downhill side of Via Del Monte from the existing stop bar in between the parcels for 868 Via Somonte and 804 Via Del Monte to the eastern side of the parcel for 812 Via Del Monte;
- Both sides of Gatos Place from the cul-de-sac to Via Del Monte;
- Both sides of Via Somonte from the western side of the parcel for 868 Via Somonte to the intersection of Via Conejo;
- Both sides of Via Conejo from Via Del Monte to Via Somonte; and

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Section 4: The following information shall be implemented with the residential permit parking area:

Hours of Restrictions/Exemption from Restrictions

- The hours of the restrictions within these zones will be in effect and subject to enforcement 24 hours per day, seven days per week;
- No vehicle may park on the streets within the identified restricted parking area, unless the vehicle is exempted as identified below;
- Exempted vehicles are those which display a current City business license sticker while actually and continuously being loaded or unloaded, or when parked because its presence is in connection with and in aid of the performance of a service to or on property in the block in which such vehicle is parked for such time as is reasonably necessary to complete the work at a residence within the restricted area;
- Only the residents within the restricted parking area may obtain hangtags;
- Each residential household is allowed up to four (4) hangtags. The hangtag shall be prominently displayed in the front windshield of the eligible vehicle. Each residential hangtag does not have an expiration date;

Permit Fees

- The permit fees are \$0 for the initial fee for an override hangtag and \$10 for each replacement of lost or stolen hangtags and these will be reflected in future City Fee Schedules; and

Section 5: The City Manager, Public Works Director, and Acting Police Chief are hereby directed and authorized to take all necessary actions to implement this action of the City Council; and

Section 6: The Interim City Clerk is hereby authorized to certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

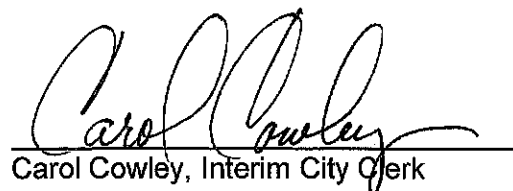

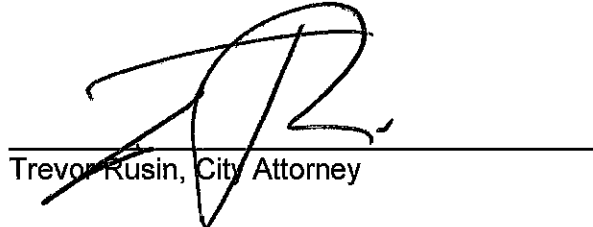

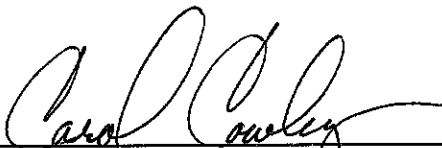
