

RESOLUTION R00-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA CONFIRMING THE PARKLANDS COMMITTEE APPROVAL OF PC-104-99, REQUEST TO REMOVE THREE CITY TREES ADJACENT TO 941 AND 925 VIA NOGALES, WITH MODIFIED CONDITIONS

The City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates does resolve as follows:

Section 1. On August 20, 1999, an application (the "Application") was submitted requesting approval to remove three City trees adjacent to 941 and 925 Via Nogales.

Section 2. At the October 13, 1999 meeting, the Parklands Committee granted the Application, subject to specific conditions of approval.

Section 3. The Parkland Committee action was reported to the City Council at their meeting of October 26, 1999, at which time the Council set the matter for public hearing.

Section 4. On January 25, 2000, the City Council conducted a continued public hearing on the Application. The hearing was duly and properly noticed and at such hearing the City Council received and considered an oral staff report and documentary evidence, including, but not limited to, a site plan, minutes of the Parklands Committee meetings of September 8 and October 13, 1999, and received and considered written and oral testimony from the applicant and others.

Section 5. Based upon the information presented, the City Council hereby finds and determines as follows:

- a. Each fact set forth in Section 1 through 4 is true and correct.
- b. Each fact set forth in the memorandum for Agenda Item No. 7, Meeting Date 1/25/00 from Carl Moritz to James B. Hendrickson, presented to the City Council on said date, is true and correct.


Section 6. Based upon the information presented the City Council grants approval of PC-104-99, request to remove three City trees from the property adjacent to 941 and 925 Via Nogales subject to the following modified conditions as set forth herein:

- a. That all three trees be removed (Eucalyptus, Pine and Magnolia).
- b. That the City Forester determine whether a 15-gallon replacement tree be provided in this or some other location within the City.
- c. That before commencing any work, the City will survey the area to determine whether the trees are on public property.


- d. That all costs associated with the Application, including the cost of the survey, shall be paid by the Applicant, except the removal of the diseased Magnolia.

Section 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of Resolution R00-08 and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


