

RESOLUTION R00-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES SUPPORTING SCHOOL BOND MEASURE K AND URGING ITS PASSAGE AT THE JUNE 6, 2000 SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District Board of Education is placing a General Obligation Bond election known as Measure K before the voters on June 6, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the \$46,000,000 raised by Measure K will be used specifically to renovate and repair schools throughout the District; and

WHEREAS, schools scheduled for repair are 30-75 years old and in need of a variety of improvements, including roof repairs, replacement of inadequate electrical systems, seismic retrofitting, asbestos abatement, replacement of outdated plumbing, heating and sewer systems, renovation of classrooms, libraries and science labs, and other health and safety related improvements; and

WHEREAS, passage of Measure K will qualify the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District for \$21,000,000 in State matching funds to assist with the repairs and improvements which would otherwise accrue to other school districts; and

WHEREAS, Measure K dollars will benefit every student within the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District, and enhance the educational opportunities at one of the State's premier school districts; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of an outstanding school district with modern educational facilities are enjoyed by all members of the community at large, and as such, are worthy of community-wide support.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates does hereby support the passage of School Bond Measure K.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates urges the electorate to vote "Yes" on School Bond Measure K at the Special Election to be held June 6, 2000.
