**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE

THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, MARCH 6, 2001, TO BE MADE BY THE CITY CLERK**

WHEREAS, a Municipal Election will be held and conducted in the City of Palos Verdes Estates, California, on Tuesday, March 6, 2001, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires the canvass of the election to be made by the City Clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 10263 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the canvass of the General Municipal Election to be held is ordered to be made by the City Clerk.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk shall complete the canvass of the election prior to the Tuesday following the Election, and shall certify the results to the City Council on that day.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall apply only to the election to be held on Tuesday, March 6, 2001, and shall then be repealed.


SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


