WHEREAS, the City Council has expressed a desire to administer a Traffic Calming Program in the City of Palos Verdes Estates; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the original and this revised policy is to create safer streets within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Safety Committee has worked with staff to propose modifications to the Traffic Calming Program; and


WHEREAS, this proposed revised policy shall guide the Traffic and Safety Committee in making decisions on residents' requests for the installation of traffic calming devices;


