

RESOLUTION R01-29

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES
ESTATES, CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE AUDITOR'S REPORT AND
SETTING THE RATE FOR THE FIRE AND PARAMEDIC SERVICES SPECIAL
TAX TO FINANCE FIRE AND PARAMEDIC SERVICES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001-02**

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Palos Verdes Estates on March 6, 2001 approved Ordinance No. 630, which authorizes the City to levy the Fire and Paramedic Services Special Tax for the purpose of funding fire and paramedic service, currently provided under contract to the City by the Consolidated Fire Protection District of Los Angeles County; and

WHEREAS, the approval of special tax included the procedures for determining the rate and method of apportionment of the Fire and Paramedic Services Special Tax, the maximum rate to be levied and enabling the collection and providing for the administration of such tax; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused to be prepared a report entitled "Fire and Paramedic Services Special Tax Report, Fiscal Year 2001-02, Auditor's Report, City of Palos Verdes Estates" (the "Auditor's Report"), which is presented by the City Clerk and attached hereto as "Exhibit A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has budgeted and appropriated the revenues from the special tax and the expenditures associated with the cost of fire and paramedic contract services and administration as part of the City's fiscal year 2001-02 budget,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates as follows:


Section 1. The City Council has duly considered the Auditor's Report, attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference, and hereby approves said report as filed.

Section 2. The City Council hereby establishes the tax rates as set forth in the Auditor's Report for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002.

Section 3. The City Council hereby resolves that the proceeds from any funds collected from the Fire and Paramedic Services Special Tax shall be expended for fire and paramedic services.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of Resolution R01-29 and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


