

RESOLUTION 03-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR CREATION OF 300' RADIUS MAP AND ASSOCIATED MAILING MATRIX AND REVISING FEES RELATED TO PUBLIC WORKS PERMITS

WHEREAS, State law and the Palos Verdes Estates Municipal Code require the performance of certain application processing, plan review, inspections, and other services by certain City officers, employees, and consultants for the purpose of safeguarding the public health, safety, and welfare and to the benefit of private individuals seeking certain development rights; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate for the cost of such services to be borne by the users and beneficiaries thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has undertaken a comprehensive review and analysis of the cost of providing such services, which has been received and considered by the City Council, and on which was held a duly noticed public hearing as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts the following fees for services:

- A. Fees for public works encroachment and excavation permits shall be as set forth in Schedule #1 attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.
- B. A fee for preparation of a 300' radius map and an associated mailing matrix in the amount of \$300 which shall be henceforth reviewed and adjusted as appropriate when the City Council reviews the fees and charges for the Building and Safety, Public Works, and Planning services.

Section 2. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the fees established by this resolution do not exceed the estimated costs of providing the service for which the fee is imposed.

Section 3. Any fee previously adopted by the City Council for any permit, service, or other matter for which a fee is provided by this resolution is hereby rescinded, provided, however, that nothing in this resolution shall be deemed to rescind or repeal any fee not specifically superseded by this resolution.

Section 4. The Public Works Director shall not less than annually prepare a report to the City Council in accordance with the methodology adopted by the City Council on

November 9, 1993, on the cost of development services and the adequacy of the fees imposed by the City Council to recover those costs.






