

RESOLUTION R05-31

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES
ESTATES SUPPORTING SCHOOL BOND MEASURES R AND S AND URGING
THEIR PASSAGE AT THE NOVEMBER 8, 2005 LOCAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, an election was duly called and regularly held in the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District on June 6, 2000, at which Measure K was submitted to the electors of the District; and

WHEREAS, Measure K passed and authorized the expenditure of \$46 million (coupled with \$24,300,000 in State matching funds) to be used specifically to renovate and repair schools throughout the District; and

WHEREAS, the Measure K State matching funds did not finance all of the facility needs at the District and there is further need to rehabilitate, repair, renovate and improve school facilities within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District recommends the passage of Measure R (Core Academic Facility Repair and Construction Bond of 2005) and Measure S (Co-Curricular Facility Repair and Construction Bond of 2005) in the amount of \$40 million to complete the final phase of school facility needs necessary for safety, class size reduction, and infrastructure and technology at the local election on November 8, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the passage of these measures by the electorate will qualify the District for approximately \$11 million of additional State matching funds; and

WHEREAS, \$3,124,000 of the bond measures have been earmarked for projects to repair and renovate the deteriorating, historically significant portion of Malaga Cove School; and

WHEREAS, funds have also been designated for critical projects at Palos Verdes High School, Palos Verdes Intermediate School, Montemalaga Elementary School, Lunada Bay Elementary School and Valmonte Administration Center; and

WHEREAS, Measures R and S dollars will benefit every student within the Palos Verdes Unified School District, and enhance the educational opportunities at one of the State's premiere school districts; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of an outstanding school district with modern educational facilities are enjoyed by all members of the community-at-large, and, as such, are worthy of community-wide support.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates does hereby support the passage of School Bond Measures R and S.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates urges the electorate to vote "Yes" on School Bond Measures R and S at the local election to be held on November 8, 2005.


