
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA RESOLVES:

Employee must have flexibility with work schedule. Requires specific vision abilities. May occasionally stand and use arms, legs, and back to lift or move objects. Heights and weights must be proportionate. An examination will be conducted to determine mental and emotional stability of candidates, and also for physical agility and stamina. Hearing: normal. Vision: uncorrected, corrected to 20/20 in the better eye and not less than 20/30 in the lesser eye.
