

RESOLUTION R07-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL AD HOC COMMITTEE TO EXAMINE TRAFFIC ISSUES AROUND PALOS VERDES HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the site known as Palos Verdes High School (PVHS) was transitioned into Palos Verdes High School from Palos Verdes Intermediate School in the year 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee has endeavored to minimize traffic impacts to the surrounding community since the change in use; and

WHEREAS, parking and speeding in the areas proximate to PVHS continue to be a matter of concern to many of the nearby residents; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee would like to solicit the input of a representative Ad Hoc Committee to assess potential remedies to these issues and make recommendations to the Traffic Safety Committee on the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates does hereby establish a Special Ad Hoc Committee.

SECTION 1. The Committee is given the following “charge” and purpose:


- (a) To assess the current traffic impacts and recommend means to minimize these through actions by the City or by the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District. The only remedy that is deemed not viable is the establishment of a Residential Parking Permit Program which is not to be recommended.
- (b) To provide a written report to the Traffic Safety Committee by no later than June 29, 2007 with recommendation(s) on potential remedies, including a plan to implement measures sequentially, which may obviate the need to implement others if the intended goals have already been achieved.

Section 2. The Committee shall consist of nine (9) members, appointed by the Chair of the Traffic Safety Committee, consisting of two (2) members of the Traffic Safety Committee, two (2) members from the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District, four (4) members who are residents near the school, and one (1) member of the Police Department. The City Public Works Director, and his staff, shall provide technical support and input to the Committee.

Section 3. The purpose of this Committee shall be deemed fully discharged with the submittal of the report to the Traffic Safety Committee, at which time the Committee shall be dissolved.


Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of Resolution R07-02.
