

RESOLUTION R09-07

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES
ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL
ELECTION FOR ELECTIVE OFFICES IN THE EVENT OF A TIE VOTE AT THE
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD MARCH 3, 2009**

WHEREAS, Subsection 15651(b) of the Elections Code of the State of California authorizes the City Council to adopt provisions to require the conduct of a Special Runoff Election to resolve a tie vote involving those candidates who receive an equal and highest number of votes for an elective office;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Subsection 15651(b) of the Elections Code of the State of California, if any two or more persons receives an equal and highest number of votes for an office to be voted upon within the City, there shall be held within the City a Special Runoff Election to resolve the tie vote. A Special Runoff Election shall be called and held on a Tuesday not less than 40 days nor more than 125 days after the administrative or judicial certification of the election which results in a tie vote.


SECTION 2. This resolution shall apply only to the election to be held on Tuesday, March 3, 2009 and, as permitted by Subsection 15651(b) shall be deemed repealed by the City Council if a tie vote does not occur at that election.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
