

RESOLUTION R09-25

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA
ADOPTING A SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements (GWDR) for publicly owned sanitary sewer systems requiring the development and implementation of a system-specific local Sewer System Management Plan with eleven separate elements that documents a comprehensive program for sewer system operation, maintenance and repair; and;

WHEREAS, the City Council deem it appropriate for the cost of such services to be borne by the users and beneficiaries thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Palos Verdes Estates finds that the Sewer System Management Plan has been completed and must be approved before August 2, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer System Management Plan shall be periodically reviewed at least once every five years, and the City shall make any amendments or changes to its Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Sewer System Management Plan is approved in accordance with State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2006-0003- Statewide General Discharge Requirements (GWDR) for Sanitary Sewer Systems.

Section 2. The Director of Public Works is authorized to certify the completion of the SSMP to the State Water Resources Control Board.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of Resolution R09-25 and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
