

RESOLUTION R11-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA
APPROVING THE USE OF FY 10-11 COPS FUNDS**

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2011, the City Council considered a report from the Police Chief on the proposed use of FY 10-11 COPS funds; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended the use of COPS funds in the amount of \$53,070 to finance partial costs of one patrol officer position, \$29,000 to purchase an automatic license plate reader, and that the balance of the funds remain unobligated for future capital equipment, as needed; and


WHEREAS, no further comment was received from the public regarding the use of the funds,

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The anticipated FY 2010-11 COPS allocation of \$100,000 as well as the beginning fund balance of \$14,210 will be used to finance one-half of the salary and benefit cost for one police officer position in the amount of \$53,070 . Additionally, \$29,000 will be used to purchase an automatic license plate reader. The beginning fund balance shall be expended first. All remaining funds shall be available for future capital needs of the Police Department as recommended by the Police Chief and approved by the City Council.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of Resolution R11-01 and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


