

**RESOLUTION R14-10**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA  
APPROVING THE USE OF FY 13-14 COPS FUNDS**

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2014, the City Council considered a report from the Police Chief on the proposed use of FY 13-14 COPS funds; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended the use of COPS funds in the amount of \$118,000 to finance the cost of the following:

DVR Recorder and Camera Upgrades	\$60,000
Taser Devices 4 @ \$1,000	\$ 4,000
Ballistic Shields 2 @ \$1,500	\$ 3,000
.223 Caliber Patrol Rifle and Mount for Motorcycle	\$ 2,000
.223 Caliber Colt M-4 Patrol Rifles (vehicles) 4 @ \$1,500	\$ 6,000
Parcel Maps (City) for Dispatch and Briefing	\$ 1,000
Retrofit Patrol Car Mounts for Patrol Rifles 5 @ \$800	\$ 4,000
Modify Range Lighting & Install Storage Cabinets	\$ 5,000
Range Training Equipment (Scenario Training)	\$ 5,000
FLIR 35 mm lens	\$ 2,000
Overtime for Urban Rifle/Active Shooter Training	\$20,000
MDC for Traffic Control Truck	\$ 6,000

and that the balance of the funds remain unobligated for future capital equipment, as needed; and

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The anticipated FY 2013-14 COPS allocation of \$100,000 as well as the beginning fund balance of \$160,900 will be used to purchase the following:

DVR Recorder and Camera Upgrades	\$60,000
Taser Devices 4 @ \$1,000	\$ 4,000
Ballistic Shields 2 @ \$1,500	\$ 3,000
.223 Caliber Patrol Rifle and Mount for Motorcycle	\$ 2,000
.223 Caliber Colt M-4 Patrol Rifles (vehicles) 4 @ \$1,500	\$ 6,000
Parcel Maps (City) for Dispatch and Briefing	\$ 1,000
Retrofit Patrol Car Mounts for Patrol Rifles 5 @ \$800	\$ 4,000
Modify Range Lighting & Install Storage Cabinets	\$ 5,000
Range Training Equipment (Scenario Training)	\$ 5,000
FLIR 35 mm lens	\$ 2,000
Overtime for Urban Rifle/Active Shooter Training	\$20,000
MDC for Traffic Control Truck	\$ 6,000

The beginning fund balance shall be expended first. All remaining funds shall be available for future capital needs of the Police Department as recommended by the Police Chief and approved by the City Council.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of Resolution R14-10.





