

**RESOLUTION R18-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 10, 2018, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW**

WHEREAS, A Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Palos Verdes Estates, California, on Tuesday, April 10, 2018, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, Notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, City Staff with the support of Martin & Chapman canvassed the returns and has certified the results to the City Council, which are received, attached and made a part hereto as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City within the precincts including vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots was 5,721.

SECTION 2. That the measure voted upon at the election (Measure E) is as follows:

"To fund the Palos Verdes Estates Police Department, shall an ordinance be adopted approving an annual parcel tax of \$342 plus 20¢ per square foot of building improvements, generating approximately \$5 million annually for 9 years and requiring a Citizens Financial Oversight Committee and annual financial audits?"


SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes in the City for and against measure (Measure E) were as listed in "Exhibit A" attached.

SECTION 4. That as a result of the election, two-thirds of the voters voting on the measure relating to the Law Enforcement Special Services Tax for a period of nine years did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the results of election, showing: (1) the whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the total number of votes for and against each measure (Measure E).

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and codify Ordinance O18-732 (Exhibit B), an ordinance of the City of Palos Verdes Estates, California, levying a Law Enforcement Services Special Tax, authorizing the City of Palos Verdes Estates to adjust spending limits pursuant to article XIII B of the California Constitution by the authorized amount of services special tax, and requiring annual review by a Citizen Oversight Committee, as approved by voters.
