

RESOLUTION NO. R19-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE PROPOSED LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 FOR THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES FUNDED BY THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017 (SB1)

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Palos Verdes Estates are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Palos Verdes Estates must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Palos Verdes Estates, will receive an estimated \$232,426 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2019-20 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the third year in which the City of Palos Verdes Estates is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of Palos Verdes Estates to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City of Palos Verdes Estates used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

Whereas, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Palos Verdes Estates maintain and rehabilitate streets throughout the City of Palos Verdes Estates this year; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City of Palos Verdes Estates streets and roads are in "good" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade improve the condition of our streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.


NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize fiscal year 2019-20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of Palos Verdes Estates is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

The project consists of resurfacing various segments of northbound and southbound Palos Verdes Drive West (between Via Coronel/Cloyd to the Southern City Limit) with rubberized pavement. The project will include the replacement of damaged or missing curb, gutter, sidewalks and curb ramps.

The project was originally listed on the FY 18-19 Proposed Project List and have been relisted for fiscal year 2019-20. The roadways have an average PCI of 48 and the project would provide an estimated useful life between 10 to 20 years. The anticipated start date is August 2019 with an anticipated end date of September 2019.


