

RESOLUTION R25-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE USE OF AB 2766 SUBVENTION FUNDS (FUND 14) IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$155,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ZERO-EMISSION OR QUALIFYING PLUG-IN HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLES, CHARGING EQUIPMENT, AND CHARGING COSTS

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 2766 (AB 2766) establishes the Subvention Fund Program to provide funding for clean transportation projects that reduce vehicle emissions in compliance with the federal and California Clean Air Acts; and

WHEREAS, on September 23rd, 2025, the City Council considered a report from the Chief of Police on the proposed use of AB 2766 Subvention funds (Fund 14); and

WHEREAS, the proposed purchases qualify as eligible projects under AB 2766, including light-duty zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) or plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEVs) meeting Super Ultra Low Emission Vehicle (SULEV) standards effective July 1, 2024, along with associated charging infrastructure and costs for up to three years; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$213,980 is available in Fund 14 as of September 4, 2025, with no prior earmarks, and these expenditures will not supplant other funding sources; and

WHEREAS, the purchases will be procured via competitive bidding or cooperative agreements to ensure cost-effectiveness and compliance with the California Public Contract Code; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended the use of up to \$155,000 in Subvention funds (Fund 14) to finance the cost of the purchase of three electric vehicles, charging equipment, and charging costs.


NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council authorizes the use of up to \$155,000 in Subvention funds (Fund 14) to finance the cost of the purchase of three zero-emission or qualifying plug-in hybrid electric vehicles, charging equipment, and charging costs. The City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary purchase agreements, contracts, and related documents, and to select vendors in compliance with applicable procurement laws.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.


