ARRESTS

09-16-2025 Driving Without License Arrest PASEO DE LA PLAYA & VIA RIVERA

At approximately 2:15 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop and began an investigation. The driver was subsequently arrested for failing to present identification and driving without a license.

09-16-2025 Possession of Stolen Property Arrest 3100 BLK PALOS VERDES DR N

At approximately 6:40 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop and began an investigation. The officers located property that did not belong to the subjects. Both the driver and the passenger were arrested for possession of stolen property.

At approximately 10:45 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop and began an investigation. The driver was subsequently arrested for violating a court order.
