**ARRESTS**

**10-16-2025                      Mail Theft Arrest    PALOS VERDES DR N & VIA LAS VEGAS**

At approximately 8:50 PM, officers observed a vehicle parked adjacent to a drop-off mailbox with its lights off and conducted a traffic stop. Officers located burglary tools consistent with mail theft and mail that did not belong to the occupants of the vehicle. Both the driver and passenger were arrested with possession of burglary tools, conspiracy to commit a crime, and mail theft.

At approximately 10 PM, officers conducted a traffic stop and began a DUI investigation. The driver was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence, possession of a controlled substance, and driving with a suspended license.
