

**RESOLUTION NO. R25-37**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, APPROPRIATING UNENCUMBERED GENERAL FUND (FUND 01) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$89,450 TO REFLECT THE CORRESPONDING INCREASE IN GRANT REVENUE, DESIGNATED FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES OUTLINED IN EACH GRANT AGREEMENT, INCLUDING ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS, COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, AND EDUCATION CAMPAIGNS, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, at a Regular Meeting held on June 24, 2025, the City of Palos Verdes City Council adopted Resolution R25-21 adopting the annual budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Palos Verdes Estates has been awarded two grants from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for Federal Fiscal Year 2025–2026, totaling \$89,450, to support traffic safety operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funds are 100% federally funded through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and administered by OTS, with no matching funds required from the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funds must be used exclusively for enforcement operations, community engagement, and education campaigns as specified in the grant agreements, and cannot be used for general patrol overtime or to offset staffing shortages; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the grant-funded activities align with the City’s priorities of public safety, good governance, and fiscal sustainability; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure compliance with OTS reimbursement and audit requirements, the City Manager is authorized to establish dedicated budget accounts within the Police Department’s Operations Division budget for tracking all OTS-related revenues and expenditures.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Palos Verdes Estates, California does hereby **RESOLVE, DETERMINE, and ORDER**:

**SECTION 1:** The City Council hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$89,450 in grant revenue received from the California Office of Traffic Safety to the Police Department for traffic safety operations as outlined in the grant agreements; and

**SECTION 2:** City Manager is authorized to create dedicated budget accounts within the Police Department’s Operations Division budget to manage all OTS-related revenues and expenditures, in accordance with OTS guidelines and best practices.

**SECTION 3:** The City Clerk is directed to certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
