ARRESTS

04-21-2026 **False Tabs and Expired Registration Citation** **2000 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W**

At approximately 8:35 AM, officers conducted a traffic stop and began an investigation. The driver was subsequently issued a misdemeanor citation for displaying false tabs and expired registration.

04-21-2026 **Prowling Arrest** **600 BLK PASEO DEL MAR**

At approximately 9:40 AM, officers observed a subject who appeared to be disheveled emerging from a driveway. Officers contacted the subject and began an investigation. Officers discovered the subject had an outstanding arrest warrant and determined that the subject was lingering in the driveway with no lawful purpose and intended to commit a crime. The subject was arrested for prowling and for an active arrest warrant.

04-22-2026 **Possession of a Controlled Substance Citation** **PALOS VERDES DR N & VIA COLUSA**

At approximately 8:55 PM, officers conducted a traffic stop and began an investigation. The driver was subsequently issued a misdemeanor citation for possession of a controlled substance.

04-23-2026 **Warrant Arrest/Possession of Burglary Tools Arrest** **100 BLK VIA LAS VEGAS**

At approximately 9:30 AM, officers responded to a welfare check on a male transient sleeping on the side of the road. The officers arrived on scene, located the transient, and began an investigation. The transient was subsequently arrested for two open active arrest warrants, possession of burglary tools, possession of ammunition, and misappropriation of property.

Sometime between 5 PM and 10:15 PM, unknown suspect(s) climbed the rear-facing balcony and then smashed the rear balcony glass door to gain entrance into the residence. Unknown suspect(s) removed the victim's property and fled.
