10-10-17 Identity Theft Unknown

Prior to 10-10-17, unknown suspect(s) obtain the victim's personal identifying information by unknown means and open two unauthorized credit card accounts.

10-11-17 Traffic Offense 3800 BIK PVDN

At approximately 2:02 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver for Driving on a Suspended License.

10-12-17 Identity Theft Unknown

Prior to 10-12-17, unknown suspect(s) obtain the victim's credit card and banking information by unknown means and charge unauthorized items to the card without the victim's consent. The suspect(s) also divert the victim's mail to a new mailing address in order to obtain additional victim information.

10-12-17 Impaired Driver PV BLVD & Calle Mayor

At approximately 12:34 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver for Driving under the Influence of Alcohol.

10-13-17 Vehicle Burglary 3300 BIK PVDN

Prior to 8:40 AM, unknown suspect(s) enter the victim's vehicle by unknown means and remove miscellaneous property.

10-13-17 Vehicle Burglary 2200 BIK Paseo Del Mar

At approximately 9:20 AM, officers were dispatched to the area when a suspect was observed entering the victim's vehicles and removing property. The suspect fled the location, but was later spotted by an officer and arrested for Burglary and Possession of Burglary Tools.

10-13-17 Identity Theft Unknown

Prior to 10-13-17, an unknown suspect pretended to be a customer service representative for Facebook and directed the victim to provide them with Apple iTunes gift card pin numbers in exchange for Facebook technical support services. The suspect then uses the iTunes gift card pin numbers to obtain funds from the gift cards without providing any technical support services.

10-13-17 Vehicle Theft 3300 BIK PVDN

Prior to 9:54 AM, unknown suspect(s) entered the victim's unlocked vehicle and removed the keys from the center console. The suspect(s) then start the vehicle and move it approximately 200 feet and remove the victim's property.

10-13-17 Burglary 2100 BIK PVDW

At approximately 1:30 AM, an officer investigating a suspicious vehicle arrested four suspects for Suspicion of Burglary and Possession of stolen property.

10-15-17 Drugs Paseo Del Mar & Avon Rd
